- 下一個家教會會議將在 4月14日上午10點在學校餐廳舉行。

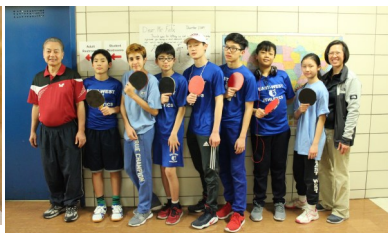
親愛的家長協調員：
