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## **SCHOOL LEADERSHIP TEAM**

### **April 17th, 2018 MINUTES**

#### **Review of the minutes from previous meeting:**

- Minutes reviewed by Mr Cromer
- Question from parent on what is SIT. Mr Cromer explained the School Improvement Team and explained the purpose of the spring break academic program.
- Parent concerned about being notified right away if there is a lockdown. She stated "If there is a lockdown at 8am I want to know to 8am".
  - Curzio stated if you go online you can sign up for notifications.
  - Mr Cromer explained that it may not be possible due to the severity of the situation. Notifying parents is seen as something important so we will work on notifying the parents as soon as possible
  - Curzio suggested discussing this at the next BRT meeting.
- Tillett - Is there an update on changing the gym pants to black for the girls for next year. Mr Cromer took note to check on it for the next meeting.
  - Is there an update on the garbage receptacles for the girls' bathroom? Mr Cromer expressed that he is going to work with the custodial staff about this.
