Accessible by subway: Take the 7 train to Mets-Willets Point Station and walk past CitiField to the marina.

Volunteers should not participate if they have ANY signs of illness or if they have potentially been exposed to COVID-19 within the previous two weeks.

Participants are required to bring a face mask to wear if in close proximity (3-6 feet) to others.

Please dress appropriately. Do not wear open toe shoes, sandals, or flip-flops.

Join a community dragon boat paddle on the bay during clean up! Must be at least 12 years old to paddle. All participants must sign liability waiver and parent/legal guardian must be present to register and sign waiver for minors under 18 years old.
