From the **Chancellor**


- Students will be learning 5 days a week through a blended learning model.

Blended Learning Overview

Health & Safety

- Blended learning students can expect to be in the building at least once a week.
- These students will be grouped and assigned specific days for in-person learning, limiting the number of students and staff in the building on any day.
 - No large group classes (PE, Lunch etc.) will take place in the building.
- "Grab-and-go" lunches will be available for students as they leave after period 5.
- Each room has a maximum capacity that we are staying
- Middle school parents are staying in the same classroom for the day.





Blended Learning Overview

Academic

- One day of full remote instruction per week so that all students can be together to promote community, cohesion of instruction and social-emotional needs of students.
 - Teachers can do live instruction and learning activities with the entire class.
- In-person learning prioritizes core classes (ELA, Math, Science and Social Studies) and service allocation.
- In building and online support for students for outreach.
- Students would have an in-person schedule for periods 1 5 only.
