High School Uniform and Dress Code Policy: Effective September 5, 2018

Uniform Policy/Dress Code Benefits:

- Encourages youth to express their individuality through personality and academic achievements, not outward, or physical appearance.
- Helps improve students' performance, self-esteem, and discipline.
- Promotes pride, school spirit, and unity.
- Uniforms can be cost effective for families.
- Enables EWSIS students to be identified quickly and kept separate from other students

High School Uniform Policy/Dress Code (Except for Physical Education and Dance):

- Light blue oxford shirt (long or short sleeve) with official EWSIS emblem, worn buttoned down,
- Light blue crew neck shirt (long or short sleeve) with official EWSIS emblem,
- Solid black slacks\khakis OR solid black shorts/ skirts, worn no shorter than knee length.
- Dark blue or black jeans/jeggings may be worn provided they are not leggings, sweatpants, joggers, acid-washed, distressed, faded, ripped or torn.
- All bottoms must be worn up to the waist, with undergarments covered.
- Shoes or sneakers (no slides, flip-flops, sandals, or high heels).

High School Uniform Policy/Dress Code Physical Education and Dance:

- Dri-fit shirt with EWSIS logo, and
- Sweatpants with EWSIS logo, and
- Dri-fit shorts with EWSIS logo.

Please Note:

- EWSIS staff and administration will make every effort to recognize and celebrate students for wearing their uniforms and for complying with the dress code.
- Students may wear a sweater or cardigan with the official school emblem over their uniform shirt.
- Students wearing attire/ apparel that is unsafe or disruptive to the educational process will be subject to disciplinary action. This may include detention, exclusion from school-wide, grade-level and class activities, exclusion from trips, clubs, sports and sports teams, dances, communal lunchtime, and the senior prom. This apparel includes, but is not limited to:
 - Tank tops, tube tops, net tops, halter tops, spaghetti straps, plunging necklines (front and or back), open-back garments, clothing that exposes the mid-section of the body, miniskirts, see-through garments, **no ripped jeans**
 - hats, caps and head coverings (including hoods), except for medical or religious purposes,
 - pajamas
- Requests for the exemptions will be considered on an individual basis.

Uniform Infractions and Dress Code Violations will be addressed in accordance with the NYC DOE Student Intervention and Discipline Code
