## Important updates for today

- Our school building is closed to all students until at least April 19, 2020.

- All teachers will use Google classroom to share instructional videos, resources, assignments, and teacher feedback.
- All students are required to access Google classroom each day. When students access Google
  classroom, they will be required each day to view the new instructional resource that the teachers

- The school building is not open, but teaching and learning will continue Monday through Friday each week. All students must virtually attend each class every day in order to pass courses and be promoted. This includes Physical Education, World Languages, and Arts classes.
- Any family that needs to borrow a laptop will be able to. Laptops will ONLY be issued if a
  parent has filled out the required form. There is a sign-out form for home lap-top use on the
  school website at Ewsis.org, Copies have also been emailed to parents, and finally if you still
  need a copy of this form for a lap-top, students/parents may come to the school on Thursday
  March 19, 2020
