


- With testing season upon us, please make every effort to make sure your child gets plenty of rest, has a healthy breakfast and is on time and in attendance. Test anxiety is real. Some signs include:
- sweaty palms
- feeling hot or cold
- headaches
- nausea
- feeling faint
- sleepless nights
- frequent tears or excessive crying
- feelings of anger and/or helplessness
- irritability
- becoming easily frustrated

These tips will help them overcome test anxiety:

- Create and maintain a routine at home that will help children to be well rested during regular school days as well as during the week of testing.
- Talk with your children and encourage them to do their best.
- Be well prepared for a test - avoid cramming - help your children develop good study habits and good test taking skills.

- Is your child 14-17 years old? Do they need working papers? They can pick up an application from me. My office is located in room 423. They must return the application signed by a parent, with a copy of their birth certificate, social security card, and a letter from the doctor stating they are physically fit and able to work. I will then provide them with their work permit.



